A little more about Steve Barton

Not long ago, Mr. Barton was a local artist, capturing bright and colorful California coastal scenes from La Jolla to Carmel. Originally from New Hampshire, Mr. Barton’s success as an artist began early. His mother, an oil painter herself, inspired and encouraged him to paint, and at just 8 years old, Mr. Barton picked up a paint brush for the first time. He never imagined that 26 years later, his hobby would lead to a successful career.

For Mr. Barton, painting is a way of life. He loves to spend spare moments combing areas for inspiration to use in future paintings. Though the subjects of his paintings vary, the casual elegance is consistent.
